Circuit Court, March Term 1844

WHEREAS Calvin J. Moore Sheriff and collector of the public Taxes for the county of Johnson, reported to Court the following Tracts of land as having been returned for the Taxes, for the year 1843, and that the Taxes thereon remain due, and unpaid, that the respective owners or claimants thereof, have no goods and chattels within this county, on which he can distrain [sic] for said Taxes, To wit:

John K. Farris, one Tract in civil District No. 1 containing 200 acres valued at \$600, Taxes 2,10, Cl'ks fee 1.50, Shffs. Fee 1, Printers fee 1,50, Total 6,10

William Gentry, One Tract, in civil District No. 2, containing 100 acres, valued at \$1,50, Taxes 52 1/1 cts. Cl'k fee 1.50, shffs fee 1, Printers fee 150 Total 4,52 cts.

James Bunton one Tract, in civil District No 5 containing 316 acres, valued at \$1,50, Taxes 52 1/ cts. Cl'k fee 1.50, Shffs. Fee 1, Printers fee 1.50, Total 6.10

Heirs of William Bunton, on Tract in civil District no. 5 containing 146 acres valued at \$1000, Taxes 350, clerk's fee, 1,50 sh'ffs fee 1, Printers fee 150, Total 7,50

Wright Moreland, one Tract in civil District no. 5, containing 146 acres valued at \$1000, Taxes 350, clerk's fee 1,50 sh'ffs fee 1, Printers fee 150, Total 7.50

Daniel Sweeney Sr., One tract of land in civil District no 5 containing 150 acres valued at \$100, Taxes 35 ½ cts. Clerk's fee 1,50 sh'ffs fee 1, Printers fee 1.50, Total 4,35
